Take it further:

THINK

What curiosity questions can you ask?

e.g. What do you like the most about school? Why do you think we go to school? Is school the same all across the world? What would you change about school if you could? Do you only learn inside school?

FEEL

How might different people feel about this?

e.g. What are some of the best feelings you experience at school? What are some of the not so good feelings that you experience at school? When you learn new things, how do you feel? What do you love learning about the most, and that makes you feel the most excited?

CONNECT

What links can you start to make?

e.g. Why doesn't everyone go to school? What sort of learning happens outside of school? What isn't taught in your school that you would like to learn about to help you understand the world a bit better?



Activity ideas:

1. Whilst learning at home, there will be things you really miss from school and things you're really enjoying whilst at home. Take a piece of paper and make two columns: **Things I love learning at school** and one for **Things I love learning at home**. Write down or draw a picture or write down in each column for as many ideas as you can think of.
2. What would your dream school look like? If you could design a dream school to be built, designed and run in whatever way you imagine, what would it look like? Take a big piece of paper and draw a map of your dream school, including notes on what you would teach, what learning would look like, what the buildings and campus would look like and anything else you would include. Be creative to really think about what your dream school would be.
